

**GENERAL WV/NPDES WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PERMIT  
STORMWATER ASSOCIATED WITH INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITIES  
WV/NPDES PERMIT NO. WV0111457 MODIFICATION**

The Division of Water and Waste Management is proposing to modify West Virginia National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Multi-Sector General Water Pollution Control Permit. The General Permit covers discharges to waters of the state from various industrial activities as defined in the General Permit.

The draft modification includes an effluent guideline for Sector C-1A (Agricultural Chemicals) as required by the United States Environmental Protection Agency National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Multi-Sector General Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Industrial Activity effective September 29, 2008.
